Ref: **MAPA Brazilian Normative Instruction 32/2015** –  
 - **Wooden Packing Material Regulations** -

**Dear NYK Customers, Shippers, Importers and its representatives,**

In order to comply with the demands of above **MAPA Brazilian Normative Instruction, 32/2015**, published by Brazilian Agriculture´s Ministry (MAPA), on September 24th, 2015, which updates formalities and requirements for inspection, treatment and permission over **packages and supports made of wood**, applicable over any cargo to (import) and from (export) Brazilian ports, please kindly note that below information will start being required by **NYK Line, from SHIPPERS**, while forwarding their NYK BL Shipping Instructions, as follows :

**MAPA Brazilian Normative Instruction 32/2015 - Legal Effective Date: February, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016.**

<b>Cargo In Scope of the rule</b>	All Import and Export cargoes where Packages, involving or used on cargo stuffing, are made of <b>WOOD</b> materials of any kind.								
<b>Who is responsible for supplying required information by NYK Line?</b>	<b>SHIPPER(S)</b> at Loading Port , while sending their BL Shipment Instructions (BL Export Draft), thus, always before effective shipment.								
<b>Supplying Method</b>	Inside the Export Shipping Instruction (SI) (Export BL Draft) to be forwarded to NYK LINE, for every shipment containing packages made of <b>WOOD</b> , placed at the <b>DESCRIPTION OF GOODS</b> field at this moment. <i>Note : Whenever possible NYK will provide specific field to be full filled on our E-commerce tool, used by Shippers, for sending their Shipping Instructions.</i>

Above requirements are only related to the information **Carrier (NYK Line)** will need to supply for Brazilian Government, as per their technical local indications.



**MAPA BRAZILIAN NORMATIVE INSTRUCTION 32/2015 – Effective February, 01<sup>st</sup>, 2016.**

**The full contents of this revised regulation over wooden packages, defines a lot of formalities and requirements, that will need to be followed by Shippers and Importers, for every BL(s) dated as from above, for all cargoes originated from (export), or destined to (import) Brazilian ports.**

**For this reason, it is strongly recommend that Shippers and Importers obtain more full details with its local Forwarding´s agent / local representatives in order to comply with existing technical requirements.**
